3. General Information

Covid Information

Currently there are no Covid restrictions in the Netherlands. Should there be any restrictions, procedures and/or safety measures, then will these be communicated before the Championships.

Private Insurance and Third Party Liability

The IRV nor the Stichting Wheelgymnastics Events NL will arrange any insurance for the delegation members. Neither will pay for any damages or losses. It is advisable that all delegation members are insured privately. Please check in advance what your insurance coverage contains.

Eligibility

IRV membership is required in order to compete at official IRV championships (World Championships, Team World Championship). The nationality of a gymnast is determined by his/her passport and the minimum membership is "member" level.

Room & Board

On-site accommodations are <u>mandatory</u> for every athlete and delegate. For more information, see the <u>separate document</u> and <u>registration form</u> for the Room and Board packages.

Travel Information

- Hotel Bastion and Ibis; You can choose to take the flight to Amsterdam Airport Schiphol (AMS) and then travel by direct train to train station "Almere Muziekwijk".
- Sports Hall; You can choose to take the flight to Amsterdam Airport Schiphol (AMS) and then travel by direct train to train station "Almere Poort".

You can find enough free parking spaces near the hotels and sports hall.

Accreditation

Accreditation for all delegation members (athletes, coaches, judges etc.) will be open from 14:00 - 18:00 on Sunday 28^{th} July and 14:00 - 18.00 on Monday 29^{th} July 2024 in the lobby of the Ibis and Bastion hotel. The time span is subject to change and more detailed information about time and place for each delegation will follow after the main registration.

At registration all official delegation members will receive a batch card, which is necessary for all activities during the WC week.



Ticketing

Spectator tickets are already available for purchase online from the organiser's homepage. Tickets and seats for registered delegation members and competitors are reserved and do NOT have to be purchased. More details are available on https://wc2024.wheelgymnastics.nl/.

Athletes' Commission

There will be an election of a new Athletes' Commission at the WC 2024. Its main purpose is to channel the opinions of athletes and coaches, and serve as a sparring partner for the IRV Executive Board. Members of the Athletes' Commission will be elected for two years at a time, and during their period of office they will be able to make proposals to the IRV Executive Board and be actively involved in discussions. All participants and accredited coaches at the 2024 World Championships in Almere/NL will be eligible to vote for the IRV Athletes' Commission.

4. Information Judges

Each participating country at the World Championships must register one judge per 4 competitors in Gym Wheel and one judge per 5 competitors in Cyr Wheel. Judges are not permitted to compete at the championships.

These judges must have a valid IRV judges licence (hand in all necessary documents, e.g. gained qualification points according to the IRV-Judges-Regulations Version-1.0.pdf). If they are not on the list of IRV certified judges with enough qualification points your registration will not be accepted!

- All Gym Wheel judges are expected to participate in an online webinar. This webinar is scheduled to take place during the weekend before the beginning of the championships (20.07.24 – 21.07.24).
- All Cyr Wheel judges are expected to participate in at least one online training session before the championships. Judges will be given sufficient notice about the dates/times of the online sessions.
- All judges must attend the on-site judges' meeting.
- All judges must attend the pre-competition judges' meetings.
- The IRV in co-operation with the IRV Judging Officer will decide on the tasks and responsibilities of each judge during the competition.

All judges are requested to dress according to the following dress code:

- Black trousers/skirt. NO jeans!
- White shirt/blouse (long sleeved no T-Shirt)
- Black blazer/black jacket
- Tie (men) will be provided by the IRV
- Scarf (women) will be provided by the IRV
 BLACK matching, suitable shoes. NO trainers! NO stilettos!

5. Information Competitions

General

A maximum of five gymnasts per country may compete in each competition category (Junior Girls, Junior Boys, Senior Women, Senior Men, Cyr Women, Cyr Men).

Competitions Gym Wheel

a) All Around World Championships Gym Wheel

For the **All Around Competition** the results of all gymnasts performing in all three official disciplines (straight-line + spiral + vault competition) in the Junior and Senior All Around Semi-Finals will be added together to give a total combined score. Junior and Senior **All Around Finals** will be held to decide the Junior and Senior All



Around World Champions.

- Spiral, junior girls
- Vault, junior girls

- c) Team World Championships Gym Wheel
- There is no separate qualifying competition for the Team World Championships.
 Qualification for the Team World Championships takes place within the framework of the Junior All Around Semi-Final and the Senior All Around Semi-Final.
- A maximum of one Junior and one Senior team per country can qualify for the Team World Championships. Each team consists of minimum four, maximum six gymnasts (junior/senior, male/female mixed).
- Juniors are allowed to participate in senior teams. Seniors are not allowed to participate in junior teams.
 - Each gymnast may only be a member of one team.
 - A total of **6 routines** will count towards the team score:
 - 2 x straight-line (senior teams to music)
 - 2 x spiral
 - 2 x vault

NB: Each team member must perform in at least one discipline and no team member may perform more than once in the same discipline.

• All gymnasts registered for the Team World Championships Qualification have to take part in the Junior All Around Semi-Final or the Senior All Around Semi-Final in their designated team discipline(s).

Example: Gymnast XY is registered for the World Team Championships Qualification for her country in the disciplines *straight-line* (to music) and *vault*. This means that she has to compete in these two disciplines in the All Around Semi-Final in order for her score to count towards the team qualifying score.



- The national team members' scores from the All Around Semi-Final in their designated disciplines will be used to decide which four junior and four senior teams will qualify for the Team World Championships the year after.
- The lowest of the 6 individual scores received is discarded and does not count towards the overall team score.
- In the case of a draw between two or more teams, these discarded scores will be used to determine which team places higher. If this does not separate the teams, the discarded scores (highest/lowest) from all six routines will be taken into consideration. If it remains impossible to separate the teams, lots will be drawn to decide which teams go through to the final.
- After having qualified, teams may change their members for the Team World Championships, i.e., a team does not have to have the same line-up as in the Qualification. The team line-up for the Team World Championships must follow the general age limits valid for the year the competition takes place. See also 1.1. and 1.5.2.
- Attention: The Team World Championships (junior and senior) take place the year after the individual World Championships. In this case in 2025.

Competitions Cyr Wheel

The **All Around Competition** is the only World Championship competition in Cyr Wheel. Women and men compete in separate categories and perform a technical programme and an artistic programme. The winners in each category will be the woman and man with the best combined scores from this competition. They will each receive the title Cyr Wheel World Champion.

The Code of Points and current difficulty catalogue can be downloaded from the IRV homepage: <u>Cyr Wheel Regulations – IRV</u>

An online database of difficulty elements is also available.

IMPORTANT: Based on the number of pre-registrations received, we do not expect to have a sufficient number of Cyr Wheel judges physically present at the World Championships. We are therefore developing a concept to incorporate "virtual" judges in the Cyr judging panel. More detailed information will be sent out as soon as the final number of Cyr competitors has been confirmed from the Main Registration.

• In addition to the All Around Cyr Wheel World Championship competition, a "battle-style" Cyr event will be organised.



IRV Cyr Battle

- This event will be in addition to the official Cyr World Championship title competition.
- The Cyr Battle is open to:
 - All Cyr Wheel Gymnasts (female and male) who are registered to compete in the Cyr Wheel All Around World Championship competition.
 - All Gym Wheel gymnasts (female and male, junior and senior) who are registered to compete in the Gym Wheel All Around competition but who are NOT competing in the Gym Wheel All Around finals.

Gymnasts can either register for the Cyr Battle in advance (in the Main Registration) or during the World Championships, where a deadline will be set to "sign in".

The Battle will be carried out in two separate rounds, starting with an initial qualifying round and concluding with a final round of one-on-one contests or "battles". In the one-on-one battles, each contestant will have the chance to show her/his skills (to music provided by a DJ) in two separate 30-second intervals. The battles will be introduced/moderated by a speaker and a DJ, while a three-person Cyr jury will decide on the winner of each contest.

The precise format and timetable for the initial round of the Cyr Battle event will depend on the total number of registered competitors.

Music for Straight-Line and Cyr Wheel Artistic Program

Music files for Straight-Line/music and Cyr Wheel Artistic Programme must be uploaded **by the delegation leader** prior to the event. A folder with the music files should be structured as following:

Starting Order in All Around Competition

Due to a large number of pre-registered athletes, the starting order will again be in blocks (3 or 6 Blocks). The Junior Boys competition starting order will probably remain unchanged.

Deadline

The full amount of the above-mentioned Registration Fees together with any outstanding sums for IRV Membership Fee AND/OR Annual Contribution must be paid to the IRV before **1st July 2024**.

Neglecting this deadline or incomplete payments will mean that the gymnasts of this particular delegation will lose their right of participation!
